Prelude:

Understanding the Deception:

- Ephesians 6:11,12 To withstand the spiritual deception of the devil, we must put on the whole armour of God.
- Ezekiel 28:12-17 God created Lucifer as a perfect exalted angel who served as an dwelling in His Presence.
- 2 Thessalonians 2:7 Lucifer's fall is noted as the "mystery of iniquity."
- 1 John 4:8 His rebellion questioned the character of God.
- Isaiah 14:12-14 Lucifer desired to overthrow God's government.
- Revelation 12:7-9 War erupted in heaven and Satan and his angels where cast out of heaven to the earth.
- Genesis 3:1-19 Using the medium of the serpent, Satan lead Adam and Eve to place their judgment above the revealed will of God and so plunged our race into the darkness and separation of sin.

Understanding The Plan of Salvation Part 2:

- Hebrews 10:14 Our perfection is gifted to us by Christ, yet we are called to experience victory.
- 1 John 3:4 Sin is defined as transgression of the Law.
- Romans 4:15 "...where no law is, there is no transgression."
- Genesis 3:22-24 Adam and Eve transgressed the Law of God and were cast out of Eden.
- Malachi 3:6 The Ten Commandments are but a profile of God's character - character that is unchangeable.

Postlude

- Romans 6:23 The wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Jesus Christ.

Summary of Handout #2

The Law is a transcript of the character of God and under the New Covenant, the Holy Spirit writes it upon our hearts and minds, thus replicating the character of God in the lives of His people.

"This is the covenant that I will make with them after those days, saith the Lord, 'I will put my Laws into their hearts, and in their minds will I write them; and their sins and iniquities will I remember no more.'" - Hebrews 10: 16,17

It was the Ceremonial laws of the Sacrificial system that led us to Christ and were set aside at the cross of Christ when type met antitype. We don't sacrifice as Christians but rest in the efficacy of Christ's Substitutionary atonement.

The Ten Commandments are the foundation of God's government and are still binding as our rule of faith.
